What is Alternative Education?

Alternative Education is for youth already disengaged from school and in Year 9, 10 or 11

AE offers these young people an opportunity to continue their education in a different learning environment.

The objectives of an AE programme are to:

- Give students an opportunity to continue their education
- Enable them to re-enter a regular school
- Enrol in further training or get a job after they have turned 16

What happens at a Programme?

Students are expected to:

- Attend regularly
- Be punctual and reliable
- Develop a positive attitude to learning
- Improve their reading, writing and math skills
- Behave appropriately
- Gain an understanding of the world of work

Tutors :

- Provide a safe and healthy learning environment
- Mentor and set goals with their students
- Deliver programmes covering literacy, numeracy, health/P.E. and careers
- Pick up students

How does a young person get enrolled.

Criteria: the student must be at risk of or already disengaged from school and in Year 9, 10 or 11.
